Transfer of Funds Between Categories; Amendments

The Board of Education may transfer any unexpended or uncontracted for portion of any appropriation for school purposes to any other item of such itemized estimate, but expenditures shall not exceed the total appropriation made by the fiscal authority combined with such money as may be received from other sources for school purposes, i.e., grants, reimbursements, etc.

Funding for increase in staffing must go through the Board of Education.

The Superintendent is authorized to transfer funds in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 from any budget line item, under emergency conditions, if the urgent need for the transfer prevents the Board from meeting in a timely fashion to consider such transfer. All transfers made in such instances shall be announced at the next regularly scheduled business meeting of the Board and a written explanation of such emergency transfer shall be provided to the legislative body of the municipality or, in a municipality where the legislative body is a town meeting, to the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance.
