

FVHD COVID-19 Decision Tree for PreK-12 Students

Updated 02-22-2022 (Transitional Period)

Parents are highly encouraged to screen students for symptoms each morning.

If you have had a **known exposure** to someone with COVID-19...

..and you DO NOT have symptoms:

Take a home test on each of the next 2 mornings before school after being notified of exposure.

Continue school and extracurricular activities as usual between negative results.

EXCEPTION:

Unvaccinated individuals with a household exposure should stay home for 5 days following last exposure. Home testing prior to return is strongly recommended.

...and you HAVE symptoms:

Take a home test on each of the next 2 mornings before school after being notified of exposure.

Stay home until both test results are negative (24 hours apart) and symptoms are significantly improved.

Upon returning with two negative tests and improved symptoms, masks are recommended until symptoms are fully resolved.

If you have **NO known exposure** to someone with COVID-19 but **have COVID-like symptoms:**

Take a home test on each of the next 2 mornings before school.

Decisions regarding remaining in school while awaiting 2 test results will be made on a case-by-case basis depending on school policy, symptoms, and symptom severity.

If you test positive, stay home for 5 days. Return on day 6 if symptoms improved (mask strongly recommended days 6-10).
