High School Completion

WLAE offers two programs which provide a second opportunity for Connecticut residents to obtain their high school diplomas. Both have been changed from paper and pen to computer driven. MyGED™ General Education Development Revised January, 2014, the new computerized test takes about seven and a half hours, covers the four content areas below, and employs skills outlined in the Common Core standards

1. Reasoning through Language Arts
2. Mathematical Reasoning
3. Science
4. Social Studies

The 2014 GED® Test is taken and scored on computer. In order to receive a Connecticut State High School Diploma, test-takers need a minimum score of 150 on each module and a total score of 600 across the four-module battery. An honors diploma is awarded if the total score is 720 (minimum of 170 earned in each module). Go to www.GED.com for further information and click on *MyGED* for information about registration.

The National External Diploma Program (NEDP)

This is an individualized performance assessment system which has been revised to assess skills of adults through their completion of an electronic portfolio. Portfolios are reviewed to ensure that all work meets the criteria of 100% accuracy. An Individualized Competency Skill, which may include employer letter, special skills assessment or advanced academic assessment, is also completed. A high school diploma is awarded by the District.

1. Assesses high school level skills in 13 subject areas including Language Arts, Math, Algebra, Geometry, Statistics, Technology, Fine Arts, Health, Civics, History, Economics, Science, Career Skills.
2. Evaluates 70 competencies in 13 areas including, Geography, History, Science, Financial Literacy, Health Literacy, Civic Literacy and Twenty-First Century Workplace
3. Includes Common Core standards.
4. Offers flexible scheduling and confidentiality.
