VACCINATION OF STUDENTS 12 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER

The Farmington Valley Health District (FVHD) is hosting vaccination clinics for students 12 years of age and older, with residence or school attendance in our district. If you would like to sign your child up for vaccination, please review the eligibility criteria and complete the steps below.

Eligibility and Vaccination Clinic Dates:

- Tuesday, May 18 first dose and Tuesday, June 8 second dose at East Granby High School
 - For students that reside or attend school in the FVHD born on, or before 5/18/2009
- Saturday, May 22 first dose and Saturday, June 12 second dose at Henry James Middle School, Simsbury
 - For students that reside or attend school in the FVHD born on, or before 5/22/2009

Registration Instructions:

- 1. Review the attached Pfizer Fact Sheet for Recipients and Caregivers and complete the Consent Form
 - a. Select a time using the Sign Up Genius link

- b. Click here if you have questions regarding how to use Sign Up Genius
- 2. Register the recipient for a Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS) account by following the steps at ct.gov
 - a. This is a multi-step process (step 1 is to register on the CT.gov site, step 2 is to register in VAMS)
 - b. You will receive a VAMS ID (e.g., VAMS-123456789) when you have completed the process
 - c. Do not schedule an appointment through VAMS, just complete the registration
 - d. If you are not able to register in VAMS prior to the clinic we will work with you the day of the clinic
- 3. Contact the FVHD for urgent questions only, as we experience a high volume of calls

Day of Vaccination Instructions:

- 1. Parent or guardian must be present with recipient under the age of 16
- 2. Parent/guardian, and/or recipients 16 years of age or older, must present identification to Vaccine Clinic staff
- 3. Bring the completed, signed, Pfizer Vaccine Consent form
- 4. Recipients will remain for observation for 15 to 30 minutes following vaccination
