

## **Bylaws of the Board**

### **Attorney**

The attorney for the East Granby Board of Education shall be the legal advisor of the Board of Education members in questions and issues related to their official duties. The Board of Education may appoint an attorney or attorneys licensed in Connecticut and in good standing to serve as school attorney. The primary function of the attorney is to provide professional legal counsel and representation for the Board and Superintendent.

The attorney shall:

1. Represent the Board of Education in legal proceedings.
2. Give his/her written or oral opinion on all legal questions and issues referred to him/her by the East Granby Board of Education or the Superintendent.
3. Attend East Granby Board of Education meetings, conferences and other meetings as requested by the Board, Superintendent, Board Chairperson or Board committee. The Board will be notified regarding the request for attorney consultation prior to the meeting.
4. Fulfill such other legal duties as the East Granby Board of Education may assign.

The performance of the school attorney(s) shall be subject to annual review by the Board of Education and the Superintendent.
